**A**lbert S. "Bud" Oyster, 75, of Alliance, died on Thursday, December 27, 2007, at 8:55 a.m. at Alliance Community Hospital. He was born on May 31, 1932 in Alliance, and lived in Alliance all of his life. Bud was a 1950 graduate of Alliance High School. He was a U. S. Navy veteran of the Korean Conflict and a member of the U.S. Navy choir. Bud was also a member of National and Ohio L.S.T. Association. Mr. Oyster retired in 1996 with 43 years of service at the Alliance Machine Company where he was employed as a template maker.
