**D**orothy M. Kelly, 87, of Alliance, died on Tuesday, November 8, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. at her home, following a courageous battle with cancer since 2005. She was born on August 17, 1924 in Sebring, Ohio and lived in Alliance most of her life. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. She received her education from Sebring McKinley High School. She retired from Alliance Manufacturing Co. after 26 years. Dorothy had also been a licensed real estate agent for Tanner Reality in Alliance for many years. She had also been a manager at Francis Jewelers for 16 years, before retiring. Mrs. Kelly was an active member and former Chaplin of the V.F.W. Auxiliary and a board member of the Alliance for Children & Families. Dorothy will always be remembered for her joke telling and being a social butterfly.
