He was born on December 1, 1930 in Canton, Ohio to Angelo and May (Oren) Ross and lived in Alliance for most of his life. A veteran of Korean Conflict, he served our country in the U.S. Air Force. Victor was the owner / operator of Ross Roofing Co. for 60 years, managing his business until July of this year. He was a long time member of Sleepy Hollow Country Club and the NRA. Victor, in his early days, enjoyed hunting, fishing, boating, skiing & golfing. He was also an avid fan of movies and was a self-taught organ player. Victor is survived by his wife, Patricia J.
