Lonnie E. Butner, 76, of Alliance, died on Thursday, March 2, 2006, at 12:45 p.m. at Community Care Center. Lonnie was born in Alliance on December 7, 1929, and lived all of his life in Alliance. A graduate of Alliance High School, he was a U.S. Marine and served in the Korean War. Mr. Butner was a shear operator and retired in 1986 from the Ford Motor Co. in Canton with 33 years of service. Lonnie was a member of the V.F.W. Post 1036. He was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing.
