Gladys V. "Babe" Dillon, 88, of Alliance, died on Wednesday, November 2, 2005, at 9:17 p.m. at Alliance Community Hospital. Born in New Baltimore, OH, on September 2, 1917, Babe had lived in the Alliance area most of her life. Mrs. Dillon was previously employed by the Hartville Basket Factory, Minerva Dairy, Keener Rubber, and Lawson's Dairy Mart. Gladys was a member of the Church of the Brethren.
