## Vincent J. "Jimmy" Morzilli

Vincent J. "Jimmy" Morzilli, 80, of Alliance, was pronounced dead on arrival at the Emergency Room at Alliance Community Hospital on Wednesday, November 8, 2006 at 2:25 p.m. Mr. Morzilli was born on March 16, 1926 in Alliance, and lived in Alliance all of his life. A US Navy veteran of World War II, Vincent was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church where he served as an usher for many years. Mr. Morzilli retired from Alliance Machine Company with 35 years of service as a Key Fitter. He was a member of the Roma Society, the Dante Alighieri Society and the Christopher Columbus Society. Vincent is survived by two step-daughters, Gloria (Dale) Radtka and Nora (Richard) James all of Canton; a step-son, Norman Kaufman of Heber, AZ; five step-grandchildren; five step-great-grandchildren; a sister, Elizabeth Kinnard of Alliance; and several nieces and nephews.
