Glenn E. Miller, 66, of Alliance died on Saturday, October 3, 2009, at 12:05 a.m. at the Cleveland Clinic with his loving family by his side following a six month illness. Born on February 19, 1943 in Alliance, he had lived in Alliance all of his life. A 1962 graduate of Alliance High School, he was employed at Transue & Williams for 24 years and retired from Kent State University, Stark Campus after 10 years of service in 2005. Mr. Miller was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church and a thirty year member of B.P.O. Elks, Lodge 467. He is survived by his wife, Cheryl (Grace) Miller of 45 years; two daughters, Glenna (Lyn) Miller of Ithaca, NY and Gina (Rob) Kirk of Alliance; a son, Jason (Cheryl) Miller of Alliance.
