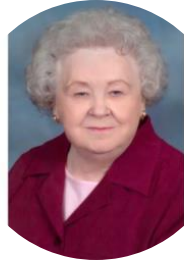

Anna G. Kuceyeski, 88, of Alliance, died on Tuesday, June 24, 2008 at 10:45 a.m. at her home surrounded by her family.
