Manfred "Fritz" Kisik, 53, of Alliance, died on Saturday, July 31, 2004 at 3:00 p.m. at Altercare of Alliance. Born in Bad-Hall, Austria, on August 1, 1950, Fritz lived in Alliance most of his life. A US Army Vietnam War veteran, he was employed for 30 years as a hammer operator at T & W Forge. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church.
