Clair "Bud" Walters, 85, of Alliance, died on Monday, January 2, 2006, at 1:15 p.m. at his residence. Born in Chippewa Lake, OH, on October 16, 1920, he had lived in the Alliance area most of his life and was a member of Pennsylvania Ave. Freewill Baptist Church. A decorated World War II Army veteran, he retired from the former Zone Cab where he had been a cab driver.
