## **Jerry Korleski**

FEB 13, 1936 - NOV 16, 2006

**J**erry Korleski, 70, of Greentown, died on Thursday, November 16, 2006 at 2:25 p.m. at his home. Jerry was born in Alliance on February 13, 1936. Raised in Alliance, he was a graduate of Alliance High School and attended Mt. Union College. He was a US Air Force veteran stationed at Great Falls, Montana as a flight controller. Mr. Korleski was a window designer for Polsky's Dept. Store in Akron for many years and later worked for Newstead's Dept. Store in Denver, Colorado. After retirement he moved to Greentown. Jerry and Dorothy both enjoyed acting at the Ten Star Theatre in Massillon and were also active with the North Canton Theatre Guild. Mr. Korleski loved animals, especially cats. He was also an avid gardener and loved reading history.
