# Joseph John Jurovcik

Joseph John Jurovcik, Sr., 77, of Alliance, died on Sunday, February 02, 2003, at 1:15 p.m. at his home. Born in Blaine, Ohio on November 16, 1925, he had been a resident of Alliance for most of his life. Mr. Jurovcik was a member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church and had previously served as an Eucharistic Minister. A veteran of World War II, he had served with the U.S. Navy from 1943 - 1952. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans Chapter 50 for over 50 years. He retired from Alliance Drop Forge after 24 years of service.
