Arthur Roy Andrukat, Sr., 75, of Alliance, died Monday, February 3, 2003, at 4:00 a.m. at the University Hospital in Cleveland. Born in Lackawanna, New York on December 14, 1927, he had been a resident of the Alliance area for the past 23 years. A veteran of the U.S. Navy, he served during WWII. Previously employed at TRW of Cleveland, Mr. Andrukat later worked for Parker-Hannifin of Cleveland and retired from Parker-Hannifin of Sebring where he was plant manager. After retirement, he became owner of Becker's Paint Store. A member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church, he was also a member of the Alliance Senior Center.
