Joseph V. "Joe" Cotton, 77, of Alliance, died on Wednesday, January 27, 2010, at 7:49 p.m. at Mercy Medical Center. He was born on August 13, 1932 in Alliance, and lived in Alliance all of his life. A graduate of Alliance High School, Joe retired from the Ford Motor Co., where he was employed as a machinist. Mr. Cotton was a U. S. Army veteran serving during the Korean War. Joe was a member of the American Legion Post 166, the V.F.W. Post 1036, the U.A.W., the Fraternal Order of Eagles and was a life member of the Dante Alighieri Society. In his past-time, he loved to hunt and fish and especially loved spending time with his children and grandchildren.
