Joseph F. Furgiuele, 78, of Alliance, passed away on Saturday, September 7, 2013 at his home surrounded by his family. Born on June 3, 1935 in Alliance, where he lived all of his life. He was a 1954 graduate of Alliance High School and served our country in the U. S. Navy. Mr. Furgiuele was a member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church and of the K of C Council # 558. He retired from the Hoover Company after 31 years, where he was employed as a foreman. He was also a member of the Dante Alighieri Society and the UCT.
