Eugene "Cliff" BonDurant, 86, of Alliance, died on Saturday, November 21, 2009, at 2:15 a.m. at Roselawn Terrace, with his loving family at his side. He was born on February 21, 1923 in Wichita, KS, and lived in Alliance for most of his life. After high school, he served our country with the U. S. Navy during World War II. He was stationed on the USS Saratoga and was deployed to Pearl Harbor following the bombing. He was formerly employed at Heastand Auto Parts and had retired from TRW. Mr. BonDurant was a member of the American Legion, Post 166, the VFW Post 1036, the BPO Elks # 467, and Dr. Roach s Outdoor League. In his past-time, he enjoyed boating, camping, traveling, making stained glass art and spending time at his winter home in Lakeland, Florida. He especially loved his time with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.
