Raymond P. "Ray" Valentine, 90, of Maximo, died at St. Joseph Care Center in Louisville on Tuesday, July 16, 2002, (his late wife's birthday). Born in Warren, Ohio, on April 2, 1912, he had lived all of his life in the Alliance area. Mr. Valentine was the former owner of Valentine Enterprises for 50 years. He retired from General Motors Lordstown Plant and was a member of the VAW. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church of Maximo and was a member of their Parish Council for 40 years. He was also a member of the Knights of Columbus Council #558 and was a Past Faithful Navigator. A member of the B.P.O.
