## **Frank Skivolocke, Sr.**

**F**rank J. Skivolocke, Sr., 95, formerly of Alliance, died on Tuesday, March 19, 2013 at his home in Austin, Texas. Born on August 6, 1917 in Homeworth, he had lived in the Alliance, Boardman and Austintown areas for most of his life. A 1935 graduate of Alliance High School, he served our country in the U. S. Navy during World War II. Frank had previously been employed at Alliance Machine Co. and then had been in sales in the auto and real estate industries.
