Lawrence E. Walsh, Sr., 80, of Alliance, died on Sunday, July 7, 2002, at 10:00 p.m. at his home. Born in Cleveland, on June 9, 1922, he had lived most of his life in Alliance. A U. S. Army veteran of World War II, he was retired from Morgan Engineering in 1983 as a pipe fitter after 38 years of service. He was a member of the Regina Coeli Catholic Church, the American Legion Post #166 and the V F W Post #1036.
