## **Fred Bertolini**

**F**red Pete Bertolini, 72, of Alliance, died on Wednesday, November 28, 2012 at 5:34 a.m. at St. Joseph Emergency Room in Andover, OH. Born on September 11, 1940 in Alliance, he lived in Alliance all of his life and was a graduate of Alliance High School. Fred was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church. He retired from General Motors after 34 years of service, where he was employed as an Inspector. Mr. Bertolini was a member of the Roma Society, the Dante Alighieri Club, and the U.A.W. In his past-time, he enjoyed coaching youth football and baseball, fishing and bowling.
