## **Lester D. King**

**L**ester D. King, 83, of Alliance, died on Sunday, March 9, 2003, at 4:10 p.m. at Alliance Community Hospital. Born in Sebring on February 22, 1920, he graduated from Beloit High School and lived all of his life in the Beloit and Alliance area. Mr. King was an U.S. Army Veteran of World War II and had been employed at Royal China, Alliance Ware for 20 years, and retired with 17 years of service from Chrysler in Twinsburg as a welder. He was a volunteer for the Alliance Hot Stove League. He is survived his wife, Arlene M. (Hicks) whom he married on December 10, 1945; four children, Tim W. King, Collette R. Venables, Terry L.
