Joan M. (Zuccherro) Moore, 83, of Alliance, passed away on Wednesday, February 19, 2014 at 6:03 pm at McCrea Manor Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. She was born on August 10, 1930 in Alliance, Ohio and lived in Alliance for all of her life. She was a 1948 graduate of Alliance High School.
