**P**aul R. DelPuppo, 77, of Alliance, passed away on Tuesday, January 12, 2016 at his home.

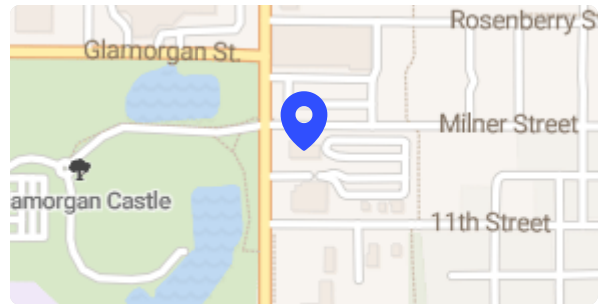

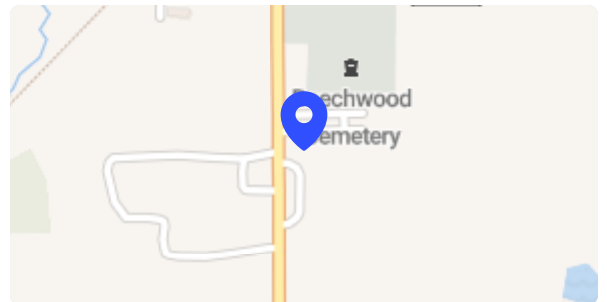

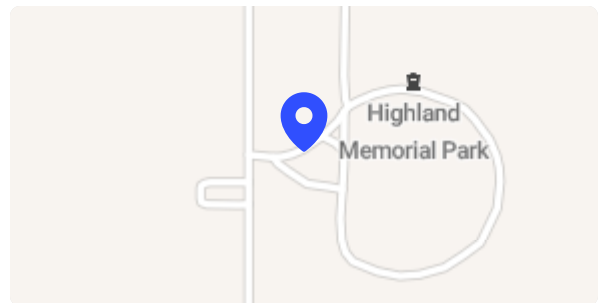
