James "Jim" Hagge, 74, of Alliance, passed away on Tuesday, October 18, 2016 at 7:20 pm at Alliance Community Hospital.

Born on August 4, 1942 in Alliance, Ohio to Joseph and Blanche (Waskovich) Hagge, he lived in Alliance for all of his life.

A 1960 graduate of Alliance High School, Jim was a member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church.

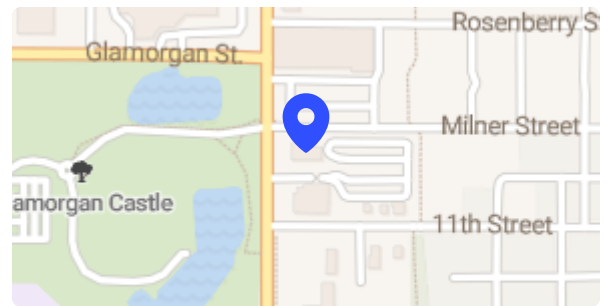

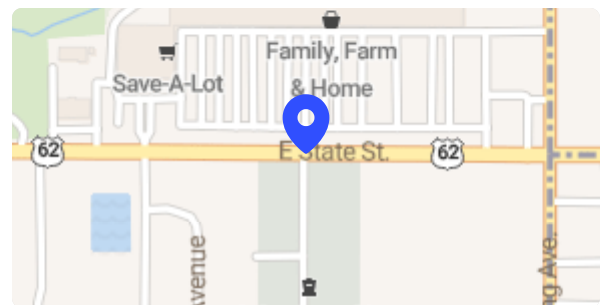
