James P. "Jim" Ramsayer, 65, of Alliance, died unexpectedly Saturday, Oct. 7, in his home. He had been battling cancer in recent years.

He was born in Canton, Ohio on June 22, 1952, the son of the late Paul H. and Ruth M. (Detchon) Ramsayer. A 1970 graduate of Alliance High School, Jim was a near-lifelong resident of the community, and raised his family in Alliance.

He was a veteran of the United States Army, Private First Class, and served actively in a non-combat role during the Vietnam Conflict era.

Upon completion of his military service, Jim was employed by Royal China for 14 years; American Steel Foundries for 15 years; and North Canton Plastics for 11 and a half years, retiring on June 30, 2014.

Jim wed his wife, Cheryl (Saulsberry) Ramsayer, on June 9, 1972, and they celebrated 45 years of marriage together. She, along with his children and grandchildren, were his true passions. He enjoyed camping trips with the family, always serving as master of ceremonies at the firepit. He also enjoyed NASCAR, slot care racing, CB radio, muscle cars, the Cleveland Indians, traveling and dining out. And, he will be remembered for having an open home always for family and friends.

He is survived by: his wife of 45 years, Cheryl (Saulsberry) Ramsayer; his daughter, Andrea McMullin (and husband, Timothy) of Fairview, PA; son, Douglas Ramsayer (and wife, Rachel) of Xenia, OH; and six Grandchildren - Darren Ramsayer, Augusta (Ryan) Ramsayer-Gerrety, Ryan Ramsayer, Nora "Libby" McMullin, Molly McMullin, Samuel Ramsayer; great-granddaughter, Iris Gerrety.

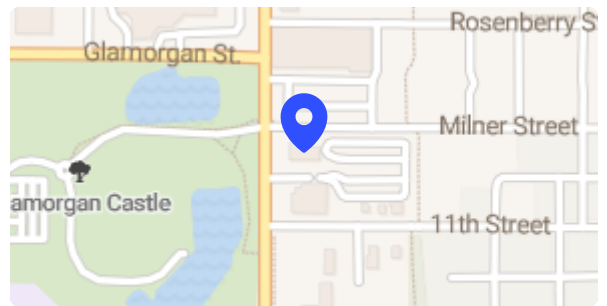

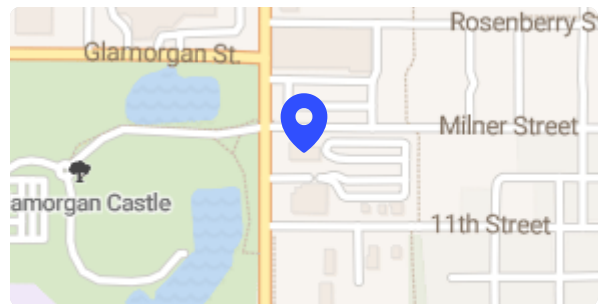
