Connie (DeGirolamo) Kinsey was born in Alliance, OH on December 8, 1930 to the late Michael and Jennie DeGirolamo. She passed away Sunday, December 24, 2017 at 5:05 pm at home, while under Hospice care.

Connie was a secretary at B&W Research, and was a former owner of Al & Dave's Pizza in Minerva. Her husband Jim passed away in July 1997 after 39 years of marriage. She has spent most of her life in the Alliance/Homeworth Ohio area. 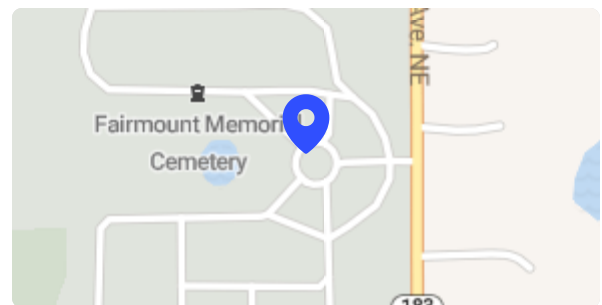
