## **Etta Korosy**

NOV 18, 1918 - JAN 9, 2018

**E**tta (Zambron) Korosy, 99, of Alliance, died peacefully on Tuesday, January 9, 2018, at 11:28 p.m. at her home in Alliance.

Born on November 18, 1918, in Cadogan, Pennsylvania to John and Agatha (Krzankowski) Zambron, she lived in Alliance for most of her life.

Etta was a Charter Member of Regina Coeli Catholic Church and a member of the Altar and Rosary Society.

She was a graduate of Peabody High School in Pittsburgh, PA, and moved to Alliance in 1937, where she worked in the office at F.W. Woolworth.

Etta married Michael in 1942, and was a homemaker until they purchased Korosy's Korner in 1958. Together they ran the business which she loved until her retirement. Etta loved to cook and bake - her kitchen was affectionately known as "Etta's Kitchen" where many enjoyed her coffee and baked goods.

Survivors include her two daughters, Marie Zurbrugg of Sebring and Barbara (Jim) Giordano of Alliance; two sons, Michael Korosy, Jr. of Alliance and Bill (Lisa) Korosy of Alliance; several grandchildren and great-grandchildren; her sister-in-law, Louise Zambron; and several nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death were her husband of 61 years, Michael Korosy, Sr.; her parents; three sisters, Mary Pisoni, Ann Yoho and Helen Zambron; and her brother, Anthony Zambron.

The family will receive friends on Monday, January 15, 2018, from 9:00 - 11:00 a.m. at Regina Coeli Catholic Church. Her Mass of Christian Burial will begin at 11:00 a.m. Burial will immediately follow at St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery.

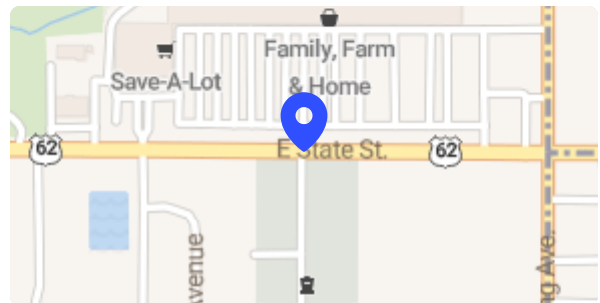
