Edie (Sabatino) Scaia, 92, of Alliance, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, January 11, 2019 at 8:20 p.m. at Alliance Community Hospital.

Born on March 10, 1926 in Summitville, Ohio to Angelo and Marie (Dangelo) Sabatino, she lived in Alliance most of her life.

She was Valedictorian of the 1944 Salineville High School graduation class.

Edie was very active with St. Joseph Catholic Church and St. Joseph Catholic School throughout her life. She served as a Eucharistic Minister and Lector and was a member of the Altar & Rosary Society.

She was a member of the Knights of Columbus Auxiliary where she held every office.

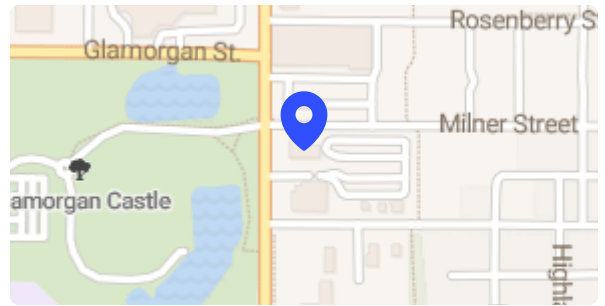

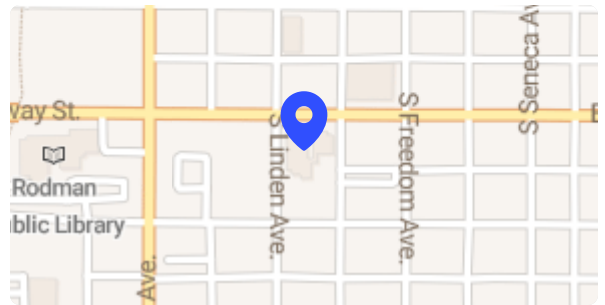

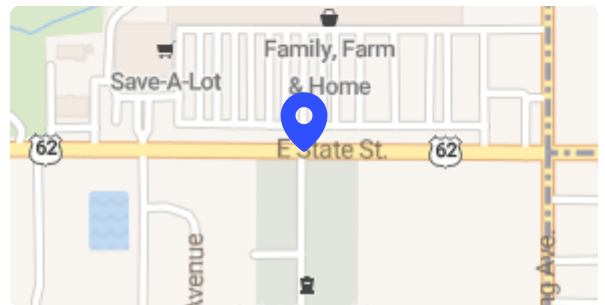
