Eleanor M. (Kofler) Yaskulka, 85, of Alliance, passed away on Monday, May 6, 2019 at her home in Alliance.

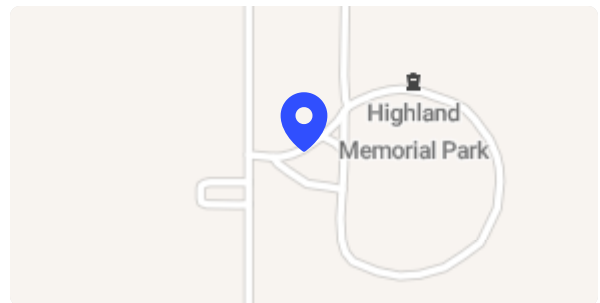
