Donald E. Baxter, 85, of Alliance, passed away on Wednesday, July 15, 2020 at 9:15 am at his home in Alliance, following a lengthy illness.

Born on September 30, 1934 in Minerva, he attended Alliance High School and had lived in Alliance all of his life.

Don was a veteran of the Korean War, and had served our country in both the U.S. Army and the U.S. Marine Corp.

He was employed at Superior Dairy as a Milkman and retired in 1987 after 24 years of service.

Don enjoyed wood working, but especially loved spending time with his grandchildren.

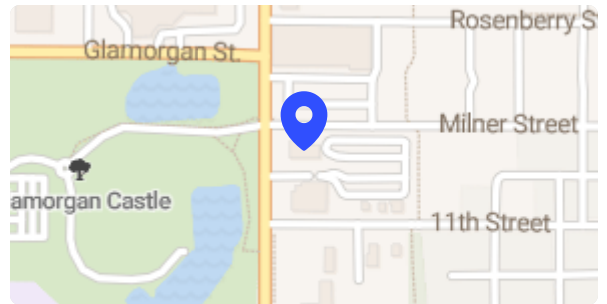

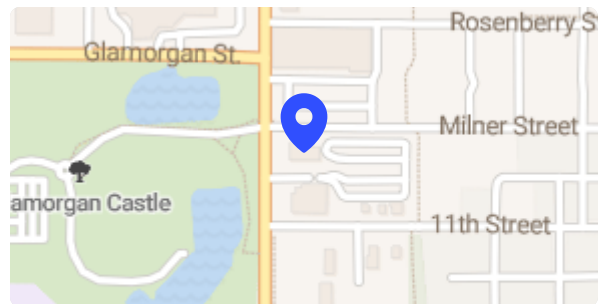

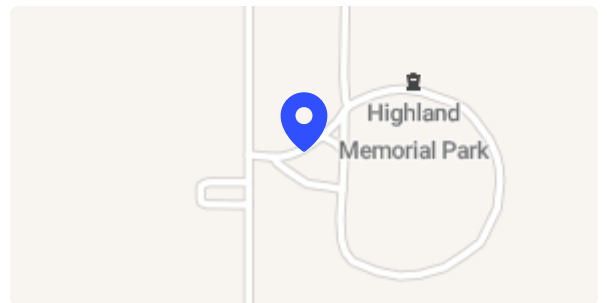
