Marilyn J. (Yost) White, 84, of Alliance, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, October 14, 2021.

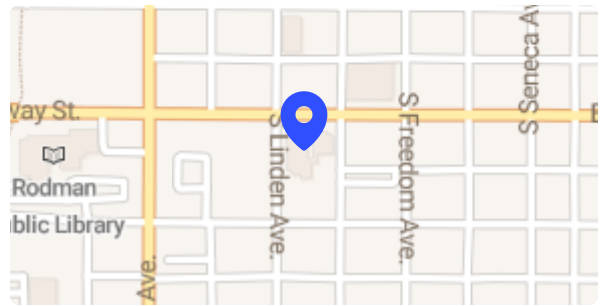
