Born on December 27, 1943 in Alliance, to William and Mary (Locas) Willis, she lived in Alliance all of her life.

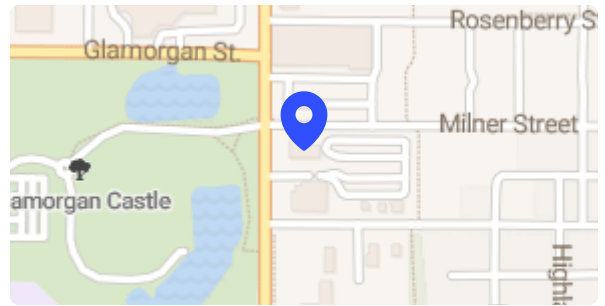

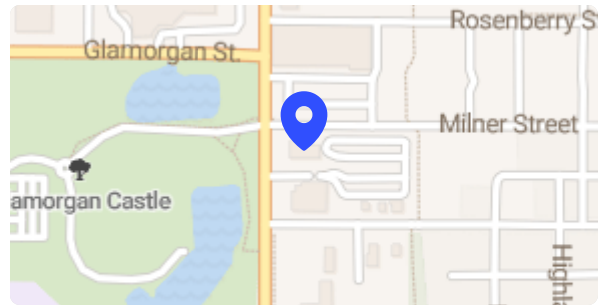

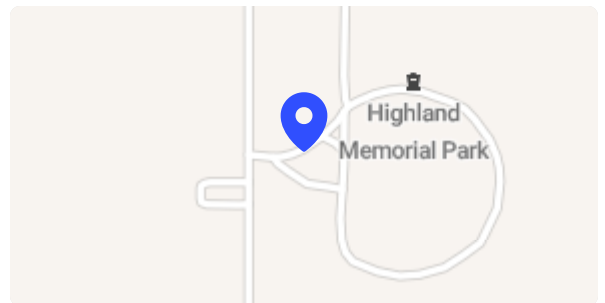
