Glen Mobley, 91, of Alliance, passed away with his family by his side on Saturday, November 19, 2022 in Alliance, Ohio.

He was born on February 14, 1931 in Ibex, Kentucky to Clyde E. and Mary Gertrude (Whitt) Mobley.

Glen was employed at Monarch Rubber Co. and retired after 20 plus years of service. He retired to Kentucky in 1992 and then moved back to Alliance to be with family in 2018.

A veteran of the Korean Conflict, he served our country as a Corporal in the U.S. Army and was a Military Policeman. He was an active member of the DAV in Kentucky.

Glen was an avid gardener and farmer and was dedicated to his family. He was a devout Christian and belonged to a non-denominational home church.

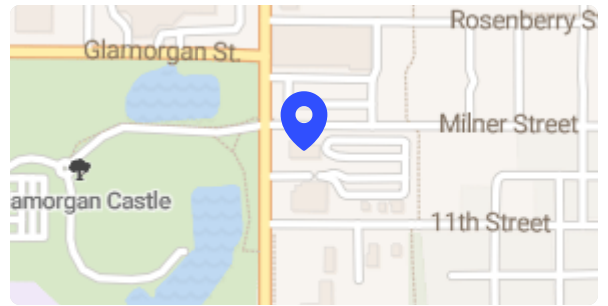
