Marilyn M. (Miller) Bossart, 88, of Alliance, passed away suddenly on Sunday, November 19, 2023 at 11:21 p.m. at Aultman Hospital in Canton, Ohio.

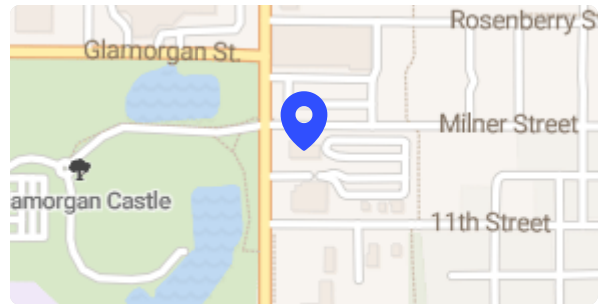

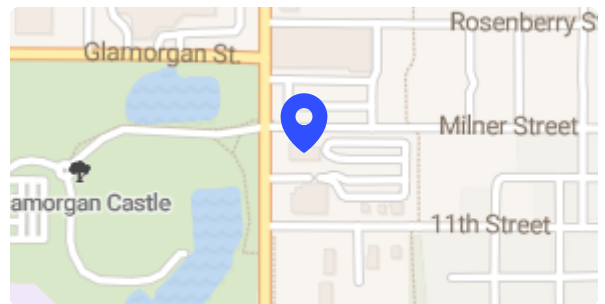

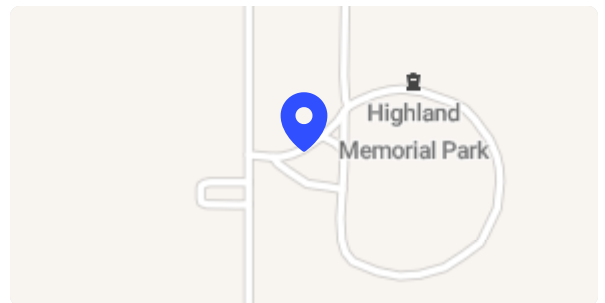
