Kenneth G. Scheible, 77, of Alliance, passed away at home surrounded by his daughters on Friday, March 1, 2024.

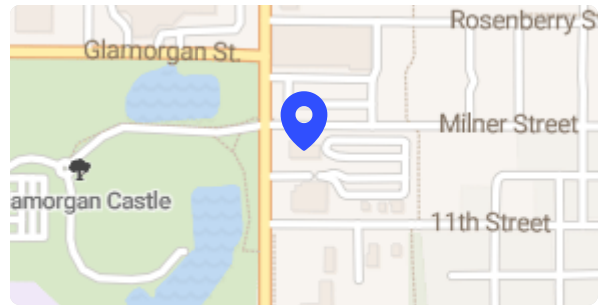

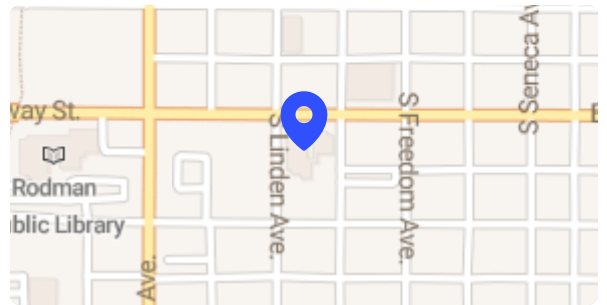

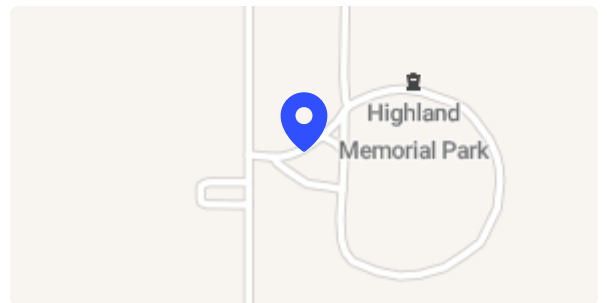
