**D**aniel E. Burns, 54, of Mount Vernon, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, September 19, 2024 at 1:30 am at Knox Community Hospital in Mt. Vernon, Ohio lovingly surrounded by his Mt. Vernon Family.

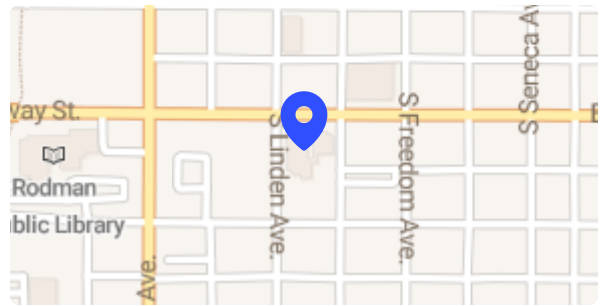

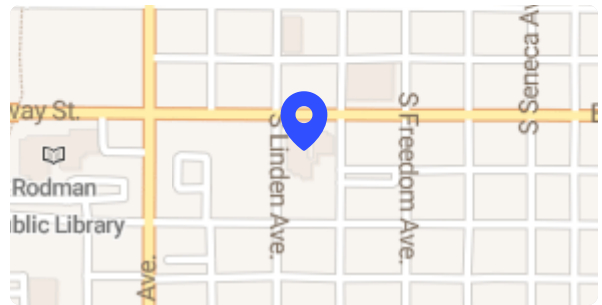
