Andrew A. Zufall, 70, of Alliance, passed away on Monday, March 14, 2022 at 9:39 pm at Aultman Hospital in Canton, Ohio.

Born on April 2, 1951 in Alliance, to Andrew O. and Edna I. (Noling) Zufall, he lived in Alliance most of his life.

A 1970 graduate of Marlinton High School, Andrew was a member of Maximo Zion Church.

A veteran of the Vietnam Era, he served our country in the U.S. Army and the US Army National Guard and was a member of the V.F.W. Post 1036.

Andrew retired from PTC Alliance in 2007 after 35 years of service.
