Darryl K. Wait, 62, of Alliance, passed away suddenly on Sunday, July 26, 2020 at Canterbury Villa of Alliance in Alliance, Ohio.

Born on July 8, 1958 in Salem, Ohio to Paul and Pauline (Flenniken) Wait, he lived in Alliance most of his life.

Darryl was a member of the Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses West Congregation. A 1977 graduate of Alliance High School, he also attended Mount Union College.

Darryl was an avid Cleveland Indians Baseball fan and enjoyed watching the local Hot Stove Baseball games. He loved taking leisurely strolls in his wheelchair all around Alliance.

Survivors include his sister, Debra (James) Cox of Alliance; two brothers, Danny Wait of Sarasota, FL, and Donyvan "Chuck" (Sherry) Wait of Franklin, OH; and many nieces and nephews.

Preceding him in death were his parents; a brother, Douglas Wait and sister-in-law, Elizabeth Wait.

Private Memorial Services will be held at Sharer-Stirling-Skivolocke Funeral Home, with Dakota Wineman officiating. Interment will be at Highland Memorial Park.
